<p>Clients are required to attend 2 Recovery Capital events a week and submit signed documentation. In addition, clients must work a minimum of 32 hours a week (or do a combination of work/community service/school). Proof of work hours and Recovery Capital sheets must be submitted to Case Manager no later than 5pm on Mondays.</p>	<p>Contact for Recovery Capital events and work verification is the Case Managers</p>	<p>Documentation submitted weekly</p>
